We are currently seeking **Personal Support Workers** to join our Transitional Care Centre.

Responsibilities:

- Provide personal care services in a 24-hour respite care setting, including but not limited to bathing, grooming, skin care, dressing, toileting, lifts/transfers, mobility assistance, assisting at meal time, reminder of medication, etc. to meet clients' needs and requests in a courteous and respectful manner
- Perform general household activities such as meal preparation, laundry, bed making, vacuuming, cleaning, dusting, and other tasks assigned by the supervisor
- Assist with program planning and facilitation of program activities for clients
- Document daily care given to clients
- Assess, intervene and report incidents and changes in client status
- Ensure the rooms are clean and free from hazards

Job Requirements:

- Graduated from a recognized Personal Support Worker (PSW) certificate program
- At least 2 years' experience in long term care facility/hospital setting
- Current certification in First Aid & CPR, and Food Handling
- Must be available to work shifts, including overnights, weekends, and holidays
- Sensitivity to adults with needs related to aging, physical and mental health
- Ability to perform client transfers and daily living activities; lift up to 50 lbs, bend, stretch, and stand for extended periods of time
- Physically and mentally able to complete the duties of PSW without restrictions
- Possess a caring attitude and excellent interpersonal skills
- Proficiency in English and a second language that reflects the community served, eg. Cantonese, Mandarin
- A valid vulnerable sector police record check completed within one year
