Responsibilities:

- Provide direct and individualized nursing care to patients in 24-hr respite care setting, including administer medication, dressing changes and monitor patients' conditions in order to provide appropriate and timely interventions to reduce risk and achieve optimum health outcome
- Provide ongoing case management and care coordination
- Observe and document patient conditions and changes
- Provide direction, support, and delegation to PSWs, as appropriate
- Perform shift supervision and shift work, including overnights

Requirements:

- 1-2 years' experience in a hospital/long-term care facility
- Current basic cardiac life support (BLS) certification
