Personal Support Worker

A Personal Support Worker (PSW) is a trained front line health care worker that provides health care service to clients' routine activities by following the care plan / service

Activities of daily living

 e.g. light housekeeping, personal care (bathing, grooming, toileting and feeding)
 and transfers

Instrumental activities of daily living

e.g. menu planning, shopping, meal preparation, transportation or accompanying clients to and from appointments

Admission Requirements for Carefirst VTC PSW Certificate Program

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent OR mature student who passes a qualifying literacy test; and
- Fitness to complete practicum components; and
- Clean Vulnerable Sector Screening (Police Reference Check), a negative 2 step Mantoux (skin) Test for Tuberculosis, and flu shot administered during flu season
