A 12-week program aims at teaching skills to participants to provide effective care to individuals of all ages and abilities who require assistance in their daily activities AND to prepare participants for employment

A Personal Care Aid is a trained front –line worker who assists clients of all ages and abilities in their daily activities such as light housekeeping, doing laundry, companionship, meals/snacks preparation, assisting clients in eating and bathing set up....

## Admission requirements

- ◆ *Adults, at least 18-year old, referred by Ontario Works*
- ◆ *Pass a Screening interview*
- ◆ *Pass Vulnerable section screening*
- ◆ *A negative 2-step Mantoux(skin) test for Tuberculosis, and flu shot administered during flu season*

**Program includes:** ( Medium of instruction: English)

**Theory module**  
**6-week, 150 hrs**

Role of PCA & legislation; individuality; communication & terminology; safety & risk management; effects of physical & mental conditions on mobility; hygiene; first aid & CPR training; abuse; dementia care; food handler certification; management of household & meal preparation; palliative care/grieving; technology & job search training

**Field placement**  
**3-week, 75 hrs**

Provide participants the opportunity to apply newfound skills in real–life situations & in working environment, enhance participants' confidence to explore future career opportunities

**Workplace English**  
**Enrichment**  
**3-week, 75 hrs**

Improve participants' English in working environment
